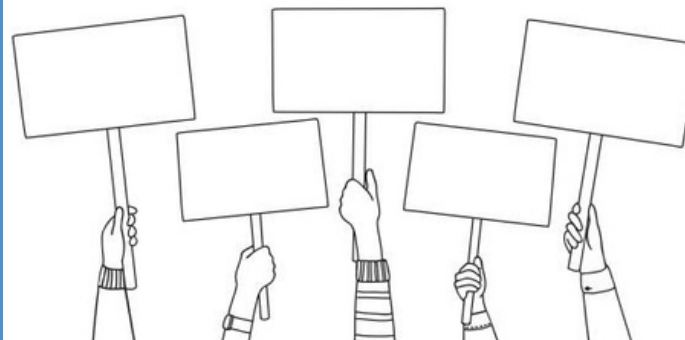

10 SECOND APOLOGETICS



Let's learn some quick premise and conclusion arguments to combat the most common pro-choice arguments.

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EQUAL RIGHTS ARGUMENT

Premise 1: People have a right to equal protection from violence.

Premise 2: All human adults and human infants are people. Squirrels may have some rights, but they are not people.

Premise 3: There must be some trait or unifying factor for why human adults and human infants are people.

Premise 4: Something like our human nature is the only trait that human adults and human infants possess equally but squirrels do not.

Intermediate Conclusion: Something like our human nature defines "personhood" or who is considered a person.

Premise 5: The unborn also possess human nature.

Conclusion: The unborn are people and therefore have a right to equal protection from violence.

RIGHT-TO-LIFE SUPERSEDES SOVEREIGN ZONE ARGUMENT

Premise 1: Every innocent human being has a fundamental right not to be intentionally killed.

Premise 2: A fetus is an innocent human being.

Premise 3: The right to bodily autonomy does not include the right to intentionally kill an innocent human being.

Conclusion: Therefore, bodily autonomy does not justify abortion.

COMPETING RIGHTS ARGUMENT

Premise 1: When two rights conflict, the more fundamental right takes precedence.

Premise 2: The right to life is more fundamental than the right to bodily autonomy because all other rights depend upon being alive.

Premise 3: Abortion intentionally ends the life of a fetus.

Conclusion: Therefore, the fetus's right to life outweighs the mother's claim to bodily autonomy in the context of abortion.

BEST ARGUMENTS



PRACTICAL DIALOGUE TIPS

Some things to remember, especially when talking to people who do not agree with you:

- Find common ground
- Ask clarification questions
